


## So much public land!

The Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act (ANILCA) was signed into law by President Jimmy Carter in 1980. ANILCA is a land conservation statute that protects over 100 million acres of federal lands in Alaska, doubled the size of the country's national park and refuge system and tripled the amount of land designated as wilderness. ANILCA expanded the national park system in Alaska by over 43 million acres.
