Alaska's 300 million acres of public land include state and national parks, forests, and wildlife refuges. These areas provide unlimited opportunities for outdoor recreation, experiencing cultural traditions and historical treasures, and viewing wildlife in nearly untouched ecosystems.

The Alaska Public Lands Information Centers were established in 1980 by the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act (ANILCA) to promote the use and enjoyment of Alaska's public lands, and to encourage the protection of these special places.




