



Ken Tape, PhD, is an ecologist at the Institute of Northern Engineering, University of Alaska Fairbanks. By comparing repeated old photographs of vegetation, glaciers, and permafrost, Ken has been able to explore the landscape changes that have occurred in Arctic Alaska during the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The results of these landscape changes on wildlife such as moose will be addressed during his talk.
