Cross-Country Skiing & Ski Joring

There are a plethora of ski trails in the Fairbanks area, including the UAF, Birch Hill, and Creamers Field Ski Trails.

Skiing & Snowboarding

Fairbanks has three ski resorts, all located less than twenty miles from town.

Winter Biking

Miles of mushing and snowmachining trails around Fairbanks are great for biking.

Sledding

The University has a sledding hill, located adjacent to the Student Recreation Center.

Snowshoeing

Any of the trails around Fairbanks can be used for snowshoeing.

Hot Springs

Tolovana and Hutlinana Hot Springs can be reached fairly easily in the winter.

Aurora Viewing

The Northern Lights are usually active. The best time to see them is on a clear night in the northern and eastern sky.

Ice Fishing

Many lakes have fishing year round. Check the Fish and Game Regulations to see which lakes are available for ice fishing.

Snowmachining

There are miles and miles of snowmachine trails in the Interior. Rentals are hard to come by, however, due to insurance and liability concerns.
